These are some of the more important decisions in your life so far, and the only way to feel good about them is to feel prepared. The best of luck to you in this endeavor.

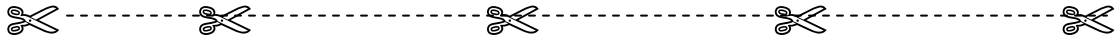

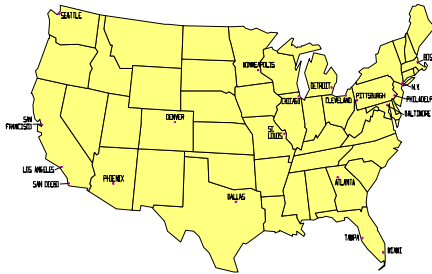
